4 Weeks Before the Move – Getting Organised

Make a Home Inventory

	Create a detailed list of everything you're taking with you. This helps you keep track of you belongings, plan the space needed on the truck, and makes unpacking easier.
	An inventory also provides peace of mind in case you need to make an insurance claim.
Scł	nedule Utility Transfers
	Contact your electricity, gas, water, and internet providers to arrange disconnection at your old address and connection at your new home.
	Doing this in advance ensures you won't be left without essential services when you arrive.
Up	date Your Address
	Redirect your mail with Australia Post and notify your bank, insurer, and government services like MyGov of your new details.
	This prevents important letters or bills from getting lost during your move interstate Australia.
Ga	ther Packing Supplies
	Collect all the packing materials you'll need — boxes, bubble wrap, tape, and labels. Many people underestimate how many boxes are required, so start early and get more than you think you'll need. This small step makes packing far less stressful.
Sto	rt Packing Non-Essentials
	Pack away items you won't use in the next month, such as books, seasonal clothes, and decorative pieces.
	Organising these now gives you a head start and leaves only everyday items for the final weeks.
Pre	epare for Climate Differences
	If you're moving interstate to a region with different weather conditions, start packing with that in mind.
	For example, moving from Sydney to Canberra may require warmer clothing, while heading to Queensland might mean more summer gear.

a basic floor plan will speed things up and save you the hassle of dragging heavy boxes
later. It's an easy way to make unpacking smoother.

Unpack the Essentials First

Start with the must-haves: kitchen basic

Test Appliances and Connections

- Plug in and check your major appliances fridge, washing machine, oven, and dishwasher.
- Confirm they work properly and that connections are secure. If anything doesn't function, contact your removalist or a repair service quickly.

Do a Safety Check for Kids and Pets

Before letting children or pets roam, check the yard and house for hazards. Secure fences, gates, and balconies, and make sure there are no sharp objects or cleaning products left out. Safety first means peace of mind.

Learn Local Council Rules

- Visit your council's website to find out rubbish collection days, recycling rules, and pet registration requirements.
- Councils also often provide community services and local maps that will make settling in easier.

Unpack Room by Room

- Avoid the overwhelm of opening everything at once. Tackle high-priority rooms first bedrooms, kitchen, and bathroom then move on to living areas and storage.
- A staged unpacking strategy keeps things organised and stress-free.

Explore Your Neighbourhood

- Take time to walk around your new area. Locate supermarkets, pharmacies, parks, and public transport stops.
- Introducing yourself to neighbours also helps you feel part of the community from the start.
